

Call for Course Proposals

We are currently accepting proposals for workshops and courses on an exciting range of art and science topics. Workshops typically have one 2 – 4 hour meeting, highlighting a specific subject, technique, or skill area. Courses are longer term, exploring a broader subject over several weeks and meetings and are generally taught at the freshman undergraduate level. These courses can last anywhere from 4 – 6 weeks, with one 2-hour class meeting per week (suggested). Workshops and courses can either take place in the gallery or out in the field if a field trip or fieldwork lends itself to your course's learning objectives.

Our workshops and courses are offered year-round on an academic semester schedule (Summer/Fall/Spring). Course proposals are considered on a rolling basis, but must meet certain deadlines to be included in our seasonal course catalogues. ABOUT THE GALLERY




COURSE BUDGETS & INSTRUCTOR COMPENSATION

Instructors will receive 55% of each student’s registration fee as compensation and to purchase materials. Each course proposal will be required to include an itemized budget that will be covered by the course’s registration fee, so please include the minimum number of students required for your course or workshop to make. Also include a maximum amount of students allowed to register for your course or

To propose a course or workshop, please send the following information to laboratory@artsciencegallery.com with “Course Proposal [YourLastName]” in the subject line. Proposals will be considered as they are received, but no later than the deadlines listed below for each season of courses.

1. Your Resume or CV. We understand that different fields of study have distinct formats for these documents, so follow your field. Make sure that this includes your contact information, links to any professionally relevant websites or blogs you manage, and any professionally relevant social media accounts.
2. A brief cover letter that addresses the following:
 - a. Your interests in the arts and sciences.
 - b. Your preferred interests and goals for the course you are proposing.
